UPDATED INFORMATION FOR PARKING PERMIT HOLDERS FOR 2016

The Parking and Traffic Commission has reviewed the parking permit policies from last year and has made adjustments to the plan. There will be no more "premium permits", and no lottery system.

All permits will be priced at \$250 per year. With the understanding that free holiday parking is requested by the downtown merchants, the permit should be considered an eleven month permit. The cost works out to approximately \$1.25 per day.

In the Ames Street, Fire Station, and Town Hall lots, some spaces will be reserved for short term parking. In the Olive Street lot, there will be parking reserved for Amtrak customers. The permit spots will be first come first serve.

There will be no limit to the number of spots for permit parking in the remaining lots.

For companies wishing to buy multiple permits, a 10% discount will be offered for quantities over 25. This discount will only apply for bulk applications, not for individuals. It applies to permits issued to employees of the same company, not members of associations. The full annual payment must be made to qualify for the discount.
