Stegemann, P.E. – to review a Request for Determination of Applicability for cold planning and resurfacing with hot mix asphalt 3.7 miles of Route 5 & 10 extending northerly from Mile Marker 43.8 (Silver Street intersection) to Mile Marker 47.5 (Greenfield/Bernardston Town Line); to determine whether the work depicted on the plans is subject to the jurisdiction of the Wetlands Protection Act.
