The meeting was called to order by Chair Alex Haro at 7:05 p.m. with the following members:

Approval of Minutes: Approval of Meeting Minutes from February 8, 2011.

MOTION: Moved by DeHoyos, seconded by Mosher, and voted 3-0 to accept the Minutes of February 8, 2011 as submitted.

Public Meetings/Hearings: None

Other Business: Review of Ordinance

Monitoring: Leyden Woods: Modification in approved plans – asked by Greenfield’s DPW to add a turn-around for the Snow Plows at the end of the Public Way.

Frank Holmes, Senior Associate of Stantec, was present via phone. The Commission asked Holmes to explain dimensions of the proposed turn-around on the Plan he had submitted. Mosher asked if there was a building currently at that site. Homes said there was a building there that would come down and the turn around was part of that site. DeHoyos asked about the snow storage. DeHoyos asked to have snow storage on the plans. Holmes said that he would contact Greenfield DPW and submit a modification of the plan indicating where the City’s snow storage would be. Haro asked if this would be a significant increase in the impermeable area. Holmes responded that he had not yet done the calculations, but that he predicted this would not be a significant increase in impermeable area.

MOTION: Moved by DeHoyos, seconded by Mosher, and voted 3-0 to administratively approve the change in the plans as submitted February 22, 2011 pending the addition of snow storage areas for the city snow plowing.

Correspondence: MacTec submitted a copy of their EPA Notice of Intent for Remediation at the former Bendix site.

Enforcement Updates: DeHoyos and Haro reported that trees were being cut down in the Interstate Rotary. Kunkel was asked to find out what was going on. Call lady who got the OOC.
