



Letourneau questioned whether Ruby Brook was considered an intermittent stream.

Commission verified that the project was done prior to the 25-ft no disturb in the Town of Greenfield's Ordinance.

Commission expressed concern about what/how wetland species were planted. Haro verifies that a hydro-seeded conservation mix was used.

Pictures from 2006 and 2011 displayed by Hoffman and Thelen.

Commission expressed concern about when the work was completed and if it was, in their opinions, a healthy/functioning wetland. Hoffman replies that it is functioning as designed and to the standards of the Conservation Commission and MaDEP and in compliance with the NOI.

Commission (Letourneau) expressed concern about the timeline of the project. Specifically, the rules and regulations set forth in 1995 and 1998 are different now. In the future, any further work will need to be re-assessed in accordance with these updated rules and regulations. These differences could have been documented in the Amended Notice of Intent, which is not present for review.

Commission (Mosher and Haro) expressed concern about the vegetation. There is woody vegetation in Basin C that was not in original plans. In addition, cattails were primarily planted and consist of almost 100 percent of vegetation; this is not in accordance with original plan.

Dehoyos expressed concern about the widening to a road, which was in original plan not mention during presentation.
