Other Business:

**Town of Greenfield Wetland Protection Ordinance (Chapter 195):** The commissioners discussed and revised the draft chapter 195 ordinance. Haro will email the board the revised draft document.

**Lenny Weeks Request for a Certificate of Compliance:** A request for a COC was received for the dam repair at 322 Adams Road, DEP # 168-0285. The OOC was issued on 8/22/2012. According to 310 CMR10.55(4)(a), under the general performance standards, two growing seasons are required to reestablish indigenous wetland plant species in replication areas. Panaccione will send a letter to the applicant requesting that they wait the two growing seasons and reapply in spring 2014.

**WPA Funds:** All NOI fees are being deposited into the general account and not the Wetlands Funds Account. Panaccione will speak with the Town Treasurer to remedy the situation. She will also request account statements from the past two years to determine how much money was deposited in the general account.

Monitoring:

**WMECO – Meade Street:** The new utility pole installment on Meade Street has been completed in compliance with the determination issued 11/27/2012. All excess soils were removed from site and no issues are present.

Enforcement Updates:

**Temporary Structures by River:** DeHoyos informed the commission of a potential violation off Colrain Street, on the Green River, before Greenfield Community College. There are several temporary structures down by the river, including what appears to be a goat pen. Panaccione will check it out.
