

Did you know that all of these types of paper are recyclable in Greenfield?

- Booklets
- Books- soft cover
- Boxes – cereal, shoe, cracker, pasta, etc. (remove liner and flatten)
- Brochures
- Calendars
- Cardboard – corrugated and paperboard (must be flattened)
- Catalogs
- Clasp envelopes
- Colored paper
- Construction and kraft paper
- Cover and card stock
- Egg cartons (not the Styrofoam cartons)
- Envelopes – plastic windows or labels are ok
- Fax paper
- File folders
- Flyers
- Glossy paper
- Greeting cards
- Hanging file folders
- Index cards
- Lottery tickets
- Mail – including junk mail
- Magazines
- Mat board – used in picture framing
- Math paper – graph and ledger, etc.
- Newspapers
- Office and copy paper
- Packing paper
- Paper bags – brown and white (handles are ok)
- Paper – lined and white
- Paper towel and toilet paper tubes
- Phone books
- Photocopies
- Pizza boxes – cleaned and turned inside out
- Post-it notes
- Receipts
- Shredded paper – must be placed in paper bag
- Spiral notebooks
- Wrapping paper (no foil or bows)

Paper products must be separated from the glass, tin, aluminum, aerosol containers, and plastics.

*******You do not need to remove staples, paper clips, tape, spirals or windows from your paper prior to recycling*******
