To all Bidders:

The following questions have been received:

1. There aren't any bid items to address loam and seed for disturbed areas. Is the Town taking care of loam and seeding themselves?

Answer: Yes.

2. Silver Street has approximately 17 catch basins with granite curb inlets, several of which are broken and all of which will need to be removed and adjusted. Will the Town consider putting a new item into the bid to cover this requirement "Remove and Reset Granite Curb Inlets"?

Answer: Yes.

Under Forms for Bid, replace the Proposal Form with the attached revised Proposal Form. Item 21 "Remove and Reset Granite Curb Inlets" and Item 22 "Furnish Granite Curb Inlets" have been added.

Add to the end of Section 8, Measurement and Payment, Item 21 "Removing and Resetting Granite Curb Inlets" and Item 22 "Furnishing Granite Curb Inlets".

Item 21. Removing and Resetting Granite Curb Inlets. The unit price for Item 21 shall constitute full compensation for removing and disposing and/or removing and resetting granite curb inlets, according to the plans and specifications given, or as directed and specified by the Engineer, including all labor and equipment.

Under Item 21, the quantity of granite curb inlets removed and disposed and/or removed and reset shall be counted. The amount paid for will be the actual number of granite curb inlets removed and disposed and removed and reset. Any new granite curb inlet furnished to replace an unusable granite curb inlet shall be paid for both under Item 22 and under Item 21 as a granite curb inlet removed and reset.

Item 22. Furnishing Granite Curb Inlets. The unit price for Item 22 shall constitute full compensation for furnishing granite curb inlets, according to the plans and specifications given, or as directed and specified by the Engineer.

Under Item 22, the quantity of granite curb inlets furnished shall be a count of the actual number of granite curb inlets furnished, including all labor and equipment. The setting of new granite curb inlets furnished shall be paid for under Item 21.

Add the following technical specifications for removing and disposing and removing and resetting granite curb inlets to the end of Section 5, Specifications.

ITEM 21 – GRANITE CURB INLETS REMOVED AND DISPOSED, REMOVED AND RESET

- 21.1 General
- 21.2 Removal
- 21.3 Disposal
- 21.4 Resetting

21.1 General. The Contractor shall remove the present granite curb inlets in areas shown on the plans or as directed by the Engineer, and dispose, and/or reset them in accordance with the specifications herein or as directed.

21.2 Removal. A trench of sufficient width and depth shall be excavated so that the present granite curb inlets can be removed without damage.

21.3 Disposal. The Contractor shall be responsible for removing, handling, and disposing of all unusable granite curb inlets as directed by the Engineer.

21.4 Resetting. The Contractor shall be responsible for resetting all granite curb inlets adequate for reuse to proper grade.

Should the bidder fail to fulfill any of his agreements as hereinabove set forth, the City shall have the right to retain as liquidated damages the amount of the bid check which shall become the City's property.
