Discussion regarding: Responsibilities of the committee? Do we need a Facility Committee now that we are in a "Community Center". Central Maintenance takes good care of the building -- very few maintenance matters go to outside vendors. Could facility matters be handled by either the full CAO, or at Executive Comm. level when there is an issue.

MOTION to disband the Facility Committee. First: Karen McCormack. Second: Marsha Staples-Love. Unanimous recommendation to bring this to the full COA to decide.

Discussion about a By Laws review and possible update. Are there other committees that we no longer need? Should we try to shrink the size of the COA board, given that we have not had a full 15 members for quite some time.

Discussion about a new logo. Perhaps it is just as well our initial sign concept was not approved. If we develop a new logo, then that could be part of the signage. A new logo would help define our mission and help senior find us. Committee members agreed to start looking closely at signage for other senior centers, as well as various types of businesses to find aspects that they would want to incorporate here. As well as identifying features that we would not want to have in a logo. For example, a rocking chair.
