The Commission will review a Request for Determination of Applicability (RDA) submitted by Abbie Duquette c/o the Green River Festival, LLC for the Former Wedgewood Garden property located off Colrain Road (Assessor's Map 48-24) to determine whether the work to stage overflow parking for the Green River Festival is subject to the MA Wetlands Protection Act and the Town of Greenfield Wetlands Protection Ordinance.
