



COMPOSTING DO's and DON'TS

The Greenfield Department of Public Works is pleased to announce recycling of compostable materials at the Transfer Station located at 86 Cumberland Road (off of Wisdom Way). The drop-off site will be available during normal operating hours year round.

DO bring the following:

- Meat, fish, bones, dairy, eggs, and eggshells
- Fruits and vegetables
- Bread, rice, and pasta
- Tea bags, coffee grounds, and paper filters
- Soiled or waxed cardboard
- Paper towels and napkins
- Paper egg cartons
- Paper plates and cups (no lids or straws)
- Small wooden fruit crates
- Soiled paper and cardboard such as oily pizza boxes (**clean** pizza boxes should always be recycled with mixed paper recycling)

DO NOT bring the following:

- Plastic bags, wrappers, or plastic wrap
- Liquids
- Plastic utensils
- Styrofoam, plastic cups, or plates
- Pet wastes or bedding
- Trash
- Plastic, metal, or glass
