New Business:

- Daniel Gomez from PV² presented a proposal to build an photovoltaic array on the rooftop of the Ambercrombie Building at 56 Bank Row. It would not be visible from the street and he provided many photos from various angles to support that assertion. The Commission voted to approve the project.
- John and Terry provided an update on the Wiley-Russell Dam, including a report from their presentation at town council. It was decided they would continue outreach to councilors to support the abutment restoration project.
- It was reported to the commission by a town administrator that approval of minutes must be done in person, not by email. As a result that practice will be stopped and the commission will return to its previous practice of voting approval at the beginning of each meeting.

Old Business:

- Bob Moorhead reported on the progress of the pamphlet on Bank Row and the Common. It should run 42-48 pages and should be ready in the fall. It needs approval and the cost is estimated at around \$1,800.
