- Scheduled guest Nick Perry did not attend.
- The survey by the City Council's Economic Development Committee of Town Boards, Committees, and Commissions, completed and submitted by John Passiglia, was discussed. The commission reaffirmed its mandate to protect the city's historic character, without becoming a barrier to new enterprises or building modernization. Members see no insurmountable conflict between these goals.
- Bob Moorhead distributed the index to the 42-48 page brochure detailing the history of various properties surrounding the Common that he and his wife Andrea have been compiling. They intend to email the piece, in the form of a pdf, to commission members once it is finally edited. The idea is to post the final product online, and then possibly print some copies for distribution locally. They have put an enormous amount of work into the project, for which the commission is grateful.
- As resolved at previous meetings, a letter is to be sent to the mayor regarding the membership status of Douglas Cloutier, whose term expires this year. We understand there is at least one very qualified potential applicant.
