RE: Complete Streets Update

The following is an update on the status of Complete Streets implementation in Greenfield. The firm of Alta Planning & Design has been hired by the Town of Greenfield to prepare a Complete Streets Prioritization Plan. Funding for this plan has been approved by MassDOT under Tier 2 funding of the Massachusetts Complete Streets Program for \$40,007.36. The purpose of a prioritization plan is to identify and prioritize 15 potential complete streets projects in a community. A kick-off meeting was held on December 14, 2016.

The first public informational/input session is scheduled for Monday, January 30, 2017 at 6:00 p.m. at the Department of Planning and Development at 114 Main Street. The purpose of the meeting is to gather input on potential locations in Greenfield for a complete streets project. The Complete Streets Prioritization Plan is scheduled to be completed by the end of May 2017. Once the plan is approved by MassDOT, then the Town is eligible to apply for Complete Streets Tier 3 funding for up to \$400,000 for the construction of a complete streets project as identified in the approved prioritization plan.
