EXECUTIVE ORDER #2022-1
DIRECTIVE CONCERNING COVID-19

WHEREAS: I, Roxann Wedegartner, Mayor of the City of Greenfield, am Chief Administrative and Executive Officer and responsible for the health and safety of the citizens of the City; and

WHEREAS: COVID-19 continues to affect the lives of the nation, the commonwealth, and our City; and

WHEREAS: the Center for Disease Control says that if you are not fully vaccinated and aged 2 or older, you should wear a mask in indoor public places;

WHEREAS: the Greenfield Board of Health voted unanimously on Monday, September 13, 2021 to require face coverings / masks indoors in the City;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Roxann Wedegartner, by the authority vested in me as Mayor of the City of Greenfield, do hereby declare that all persons should wear a face covering to mitigate the spread of COVID-19 in all public indoor spaces and private indoor spaces that are open to the public, except as described below:

1. While eating;
2. While working – other than to prepare food or meals – in a room or office that is not open to visitors in which all persons present can maintain a 6-foot distance from other individuals
3. While engaging in an activity during which it is unsafe or impossible to wear a mask or face covering;

4. Children who are 5 years of age or under;
5. Persons with a medical condition or disability that prevents wearing a face covering this includes persons with a medical condition for whom wearing a face covering could obstruct breathing or who are unconscious, incapacitated, or otherwise unable to remove a face covering without assistance;
6. Persons who are deaf or hard of hearing, or communicating with a person who is deaf or hard of hearing, where the ability to see the mouth is essential for communication;
7. Persons for whom wearing a face covering would create a risk to the person related to their work, as determined by local, state, or federal regulators or workplace safety guidelines;
8. Persons engaged in any lawful activity during which wearing a mask or other face covering is prohibited by law.

This order shall be effective Monday, September 20, 2021, and shall be reviewed at least every 30 days.
